FLC Releases New Report: Forecasting Florida Municipal Revenue Impacts From COVID-19

The **Florida League of Cities Center for Municipal Research** has released a new report, [A Recovery Landscape – Forecasting Florida Municipal Revenue Impacts from COVID-19](#), which forecasts impacts to municipal revenue due to the pandemic through fiscal year 2023 for all 411 Florida municipal governments. By historically examining the impact of local unemployment on municipal revenues from 2008 to 2018, this analysis offers new insights regarding what revenue streams may look like over the next few years.
